## Library Distinguished Guest Speaker Series-4

The fourth installment of the Library Distinguished Guest speaker series featured the book of Dr. Spyridon Plakoudas entitled The Greek Civil War: Lessons in Cold War History and Strategy. The event was held at block 6, 1st floor on October 9, 2017.



According to Dr. Spyridon, the inspiration

for the book was his family history. The Greek Civil War affected almost every family in Greece – including his family. Upon the successful completion of his doctoral degree, he converted his thesis into a monograph which aspires to examine this conflict objectively - with the benefit of hindsight of course. In addition, he told the students could draw two valuable lessons from this monograph - one for the field of history and another one for the discipline of strategic studies. His monograph proves that, first of all, Greece was the first battleground of the opening Cold War between the two superpowers and, secondly, an insurgency (even when supported by external powers) can be defeated by the government as long as the government separates the insurgents from the friendly population.

## Series-5 "Guest Speaker"

The American University library has offered its 5th Library Distinguished Guest Speaker Series for the fall semester on November 26, 2017 at the library reading area. With the theme Critical Thinking: Which is harder-Designing or Implementation?, Dr. Wassim Ahmed from the College of Education spearheaded the discussion participated in by the students and faculty. The library speaker series enables faculty and students to reach out and share their knowledge with AUE community.


