# Series-2: "Guest Speaker"



Our second guest speaker was *Dr. Wasim Ahmed*, College of Education, who presented his book "*The How of a Peaceful and Tolerant World*' on March 5, 2017 from 4:30PM to 5:00PM. There were more than 35 attendees including faculty and students. The session was very interactive, Dr. Wasim asked for the opinions from the audience about their tolerance level with a few examples. Faculty members and students were showing their interest the whole session.

# Series-3: "Guest Speaker"

Our third guest speaker event included **Dr. Kevin Heisey, Prof. Kamilla Swart** and **Mr. Matthew Gilbert** from College of Business Administration, who have presented their book "**Routledge Handbook of International Sport Business**" on May 1, 2017 from 4:15PM to 5:00PM. The authors answered many questions raised by the audience in sportive manner. They shared their research experience, publication process and team work with the collaborative authors.

During the event, we distributed an event feedback form to the faculty members and collected their recommendations. A few faculty members showed their willingness to contribute as a guest speaker for the future events.



### AUE's Book Fair

The library organized AUE's First Book Fair on April 16-19 to exhibit the latest books of all categories to encourage reading habits among students and faculty members of AUE community. There were four leading regional book suppliers who participated and offered 15-30% discounts on all their collections. Students and faculties had visited the fair and bought many books on their interest.

Suggestion forms were distributed to the students and faculty members to get book recommendations of their interest; what they want to read and see on the library selves. Altogether library received 109 titles recommended by the faculty, students and staff. Those books are already being ordered with the regional suppliers.

On behalf of AUE the following staff members Mr. Elangovan, Library Manager and Dr. N. Sundar, Library Director, and Dr. Mohammad Al Shboul, MLIS Program Director had participated the event.

#### Highlights of the event

- Seven university/college librarians gathered together to celebrate the month of reading and book fair activities which were organized by the Amity University.
- Opportunity to have professional network with neighboring librarians around the Dubai International Academic City (DIAC), Dubai.
- This workshop created more opportunities for resource sharing between the libraries.
- LIS professionals got the chances to interact with librarians to share their library activities, implementations and best practices they followed.
- Most of the participating libraries plan to organize book fairs and other reading competitions for their user communities to encourage their reading habits.
- Librarians shared their research activities and their publications.



# Field Visit to National Archives on April 2, 2017

- To gain the field experience and interaction with the Archival experts.

#### Highlights:

- Privileged to visit the digital preservation section. Students gained more experience and had chance to interact with Digital Preservation Team – Head.
- National Archive preserves the 1st editions of all the UAE's Newspaper collections.
- National Archive preserves the rare collections of Manuscripts of Government legal documents including Unity of 7 emirates, Currency agreement, oil source, etc.

# **Publisher's Event**

AUE Library and ORA organized workshop on "Digital Transformation in Education" on May 31, 2017 from 10:00AM to 12:00PM. Mr. Muhammad Umair Farooq and Mr. Saif Malik, representatives from McGraw-Hill, presented their online products with our AUE faculty members and students. They highlighted McGraw-Hill e-textbooks. They can be used through Vital Source platform, which will enable easy navigation and tracking usage report.

There were around 30 participants in the event. Certificates were distributed to all the attendees. The session was very useful for faculty members in deciding on using etextbook in their classes.


- Exchange of visits to the Library by patrons of both Institutions.

# AUE Library Feed-back Survey


The purpose of the survey was to gather feedback from the users about their experience and overall satisfaction level on customer service, collection, library events, orientation programs, facilities and online services offered by the library. Following analysis is based on 109 respondents feedback. It is believed that the sample size would represent the notions of library users as a whole.

# Customer Services (Staff Attitude)

Out of 109 participants, most of the responses 73% stated excellent about the staff attitude towards customer services offered by the AUE library. Followed by 19% respondents as good. However 6% participants mentioned fair about the library staff's attitude.



# Prefer to use e-Textbooks



Respondents were asked their opinion whether they would prefer to use e-Textbooks for courses or not. Majority of the respondents 60% preferred to use e-textbooks for their courses, followed by 40% who are not interested to use electronic version.

# Major Findings

<u>Collection</u>: Majority of the participated users 51% rated library services as excellent about the library collection including print and electronic resources, followed by 34% stated good.

**Programs**: Most of the respondents 43% believed the programs and events organized by library are excellent and 34% mentioned good. It is noted that the library has to promote the events in effective manner.

**Facilities**: 47% respondents rated excellent about the study room and reading area facilities and 30% mentioned as good.

Based on the survey, the library has to enhance the collection, services and facilitate better environment to attract more students and faculty members in terms of increasing computers, internet speed, study rooms and reading area.
